The Long Marston Rail Innovation Centre is a 135-acre rail connected site in Warwickshire – an asset for the railway to test and trial new traction technologies, securely store rolling stock and provide training in a live environment.

The site's mainline connection to the Cotswold Line makes it easily accessible from the Cross Country, Chiltern, Malvern Link and Wales Marshes Lines. With 15km of sidings, 24-hour site security and close proximity to the M40 motorway, the Long Marston Rail Innovation Centre is one of the UK's most dynamic testing and training sites.

Since taking over the site in June 2021, we have made significant investments to modernise and enhance the facilities which include a 3.5km test track loop, high quality office and conference spaces, rolling stock storage, an Asset Management Facility and a training centre.

From testing, storage and maintenance to hosting corporate events and industry training, our team can find the best solution to fit your needs.

We're investing to renew and electrify Long Marston's 3.5km test track. Trains will be able to test at speeds of up to 50mph, with the capability to support other forms of traction including hydrogen, battery and diesel.


Asset Management Facility (AMF)

Long Marston's new Asset Management Facility (AMF) provides a high-quality space for maintenance modification and refresh work and all types of on-train and underframe work.

Three well-lit pitted roads able to accommodate up to a 6-car train set, as well as access to the site's test loop and the mainline means the facility can support inspections, testing, commissioning, and customer acceptance.

Training and venue hire

Long Marston offers secure and private offices for project and training teams. The bespoke units have been constructed to house small break-out or ancillary teams who would benefit from the ability to work together on a live rail site with access to stock and equipment.

The site's training centre is situated centrally next to an overhead-equipped section of track. This purpose-built office is designed to host training courses with a large meeting room (complete with audio visual equipment) and break-out/coffee area.

Our marquee is well-suited for events or larger corporate sessions, with space that can comfortably hold over 200 people.

- Ability to host a wide variety of industry training courses - small group classroom sessions to large multi-agency major incident exercises
- The test loop, platform, sidings and level crossing allow an array of training sessions to be implemented which demonstrate a live rail environment whilst maintaining the safety of a closed training environment
- The site has a variety of meeting spaces available, from relaxed areas for engineers and project meetings to formal conference meeting room facilities in our control tower

Long Marston Rail Innovation Centre is the home of Rail Live, a two-day event that has become the UK's largest outdoor rail exhibition. In 2023 we welcomed over 6,000 visitors and 273 exhibitors.


